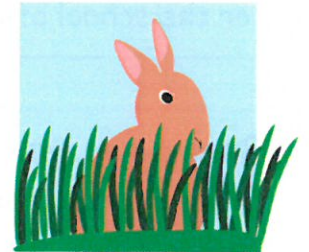


Invoices are sent out at the beginning of each month. Invoices need to be paid by the end of that month.
